ABOUT THE GRADUATE NURSE (GN) RESIDENCY

The Phelps Health GN Residency program is mandatory for all new graduate RNs and is facilitated by Staff Development nurses.

The GN Residency starts in January for December nursing graduates and June for May nursing graduates.

Classes are held once a month for 8 hours each and include the following:

- Patient simulation labs
 - IV therapy
 - Mock codes
 - Chest tubes
 - Oxygen therapy
- Prioritization, time management and organizational skills
- Critical thinking
- Chance to meet senior nursing leaders

The GN Residency program is offered in these departments:

- Medical-Surgical
- Critical Care
- Emergency Department
